


# Zoom iPhone Screen Sharing



This document explains how to share your screen from an iPhone when you are in a Zoom conference.

When you are in a Zoom meeting and touch the screen you will see some buttons appear at the bottom.




If you touch the Share Content button, you will see this screen which gives you several options:



When you touch the Screen option you will see something like this:


Everything on your screen, including notifications, will be recorded. Enable Do Not Disturb to prevent unexpected notifications.

Touch the Start Broadcast button. A countdown will appear and then this display:

Everything on your screen, including notifications, will be recorded. Enable Do Not Disturb to prevent unexpected notifications.



Click the Home button (or slide up from the bottom of the screen) to return to the Home screen. It now has a red banner at the top:



If you touch the red banner you will see a pop-up window:
