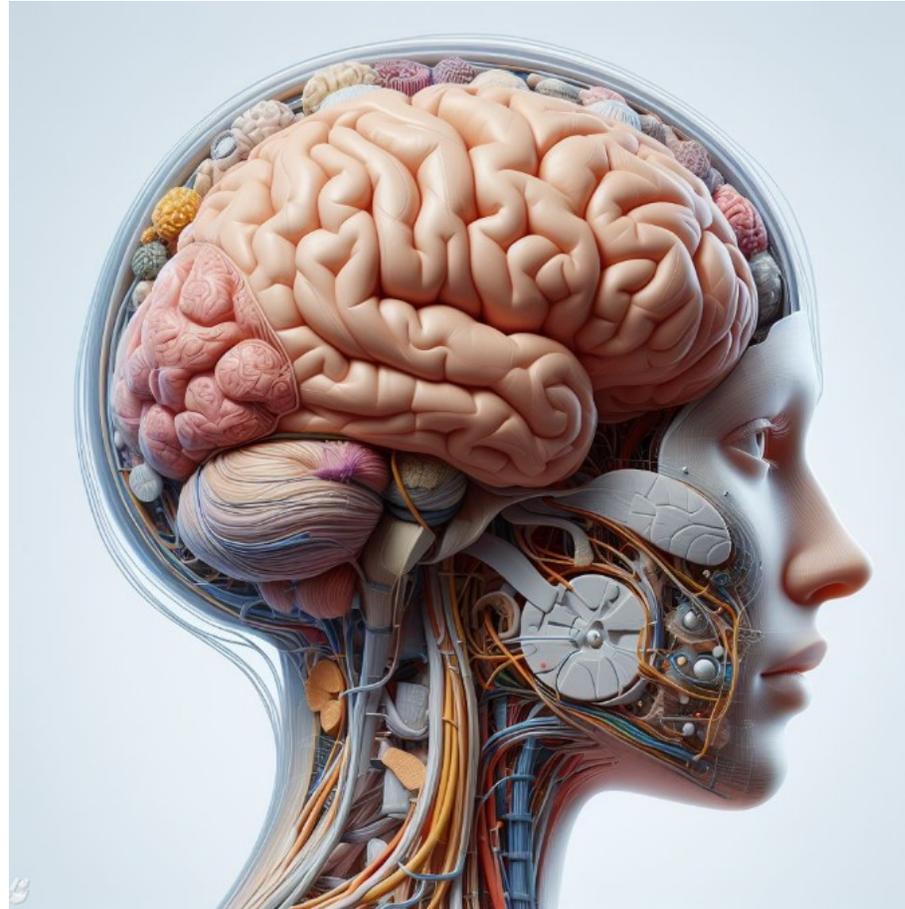

#1. Model

A model is the
brains of the outfit...

...computer programs -
codes or formulas -
that use artificial
intelligence to create
NEW artwork.



A model is trained by viewing tons of images people have produced over time – its training is almost like when you were in school.

The computer recognizes common patterns, themes and styles and learns how humans express themselves visually through artwork.

This sets up the rules it uses to generate new artwork similar to the artwork it has learned.

Think of a model as a recipe that the computer follows to generate an image.

Different models produce different kinds of images.

These models are utilized in various AI art generators to produce a wide range of artistic outputs, each with its own unique features and capabilities.

Style

Style refers to the overall appearance, or visual characteristics, that the AI emulates when creating art.

This includes factors such as the use of colors, lines, shapes and textures that artists have used in their works of art.



AI art generators can use a variety of styles, even combinations of styles, to influence the look and feel of the generated artwork.

This is irrespective of the selected model.

You can explore various artistic expressions and create diverse pieces of art without the need for traditional artistic skills or knowledge of technical terms.

Some AI Styles and Artists

Impressionism - Claude Monet, Pierre-Auguste Renoir, Edgar Degas...

Surrealism - Salvador Dalí, René Magritte, Max Ernst...

Abstract Expressionism - Jackson Pollock, Willem de Kooning, Arshile Gorky...

Cubism - Pablo Picasso, Georges Braque, Juan Gris

Symbolism - Gustave Moreau, Odilon Redon, Paul Gauguin...

Pop Art - Andy Warhol, Roy Lichtenstein, Jasper Johns...

Romanticism - Caspar David Friedrich, Francisco Goya, William Blake...

Renaissance Art - Leonardo da Vinci, Michelangelo, Raphael...

Mosaic, pointillism, cartoon, street art and indoor/outdoor photography...

#2. Output Formats

AI Art Generators may offer various output formats, including different image sizes and layouts, file types and filters to tailor the output to your specific preferences and requirements.

Sizes can be horizontal, vertical or square for precise control over the size and aspect ratio of the generated artwork.

This is expressed in pixels such as 1080x1080 pixels for a square image or 1920x1080 pixels for a standard high-definition landscape (i.e. my banner image).

Sometimes they are expressed as aspect ratio aspect ratio 1:1 3:4 4:3 9:16 16:9 (again, my banner image)

Popular file formats are JPEG, PNG (transparency), GIF, TIFF, BMP, etc. depending on the usage and application.

Examples of Filters

Color Settings adjust the color settings such as saturation, contrast and color balance.

Artistic Effects such as oil painting, watercolor, sketching, pencil drawing, black and white photo, etc.

Image Enhancement adjust the sharpness, clarity and overall visual quality.

Mood and Atmosphere adjust the overall ambiance of the generated artwork, such as creating a dreamy, surreal or vibrant atmosphere.

Prompts

A prompt is a written description that guides the AI to create a specific image.

It includes both instructions and context needed to produce relevant and compelling visual outputs.

Prompts may include a number of different sets of information depending on the art generator platform you select.

They may also specify styles as well as artists' names .

I.E. Generate (description of image desired) in the style of a well-known (stick with non-living) artist.

Some Prompt Examples

Simple Prompt:

Create a sunset over the ocean.

Expanded Prompt:

Generate an image of a serene sunset over the calm ocean, with warm orange and pink hues dominating the sky. The scene should evoke a sense of tranquility and relaxation.

Extremely Complex Prompt:

Produce a high-resolution, photorealistic depiction of a picturesque sunset over the glistening, azure ocean. The warm, radiant colors of the setting sun should cast a soft, golden glow across the tranquil water, while the sky is adorned with wisps of delicate, pastel-colored clouds. The overall ambiance should capture the beauty and serenity of the natural world, inviting the viewer to immerse themselves in the peaceful, coastal landscape.

#3. Putting All The Pieces Together

1. Select an AI platform and a model and style if available.
2. Select the output size, format and filter, if available.
3. Enter a text prompt with as much detail as you can think of or is allowed in the allowed character count. (Add a style if not available prior.)
4. Then the AI model analyzes the text prompt and generates an image(s) based on its understanding of the prompt.
5. Review the generated image(s) and make changes as needed.
6. You may need to regenerate another image(s) by refining the prompt.
7. Download your creation(s).

#4. AI Art Generator Platforms

Als may offer single or multiple models.

They can also offer single or multiple styles.

Or they may only offer only a single model choice and you can stipulate a style or an artist, in the prompt.

Aggregators combine access to a range of different AI models and various styles. They can offer various output choices as well.

#7. Some Concerns

- AI Art Generators can sometimes produce images with odd features (fingers, toes, objects...)
- Problem generating and placing text properly
- Often have a polished look lacking in artistic value
- Ethical and Legal
- Copyright Ownership
- Fairness and Compensation
- Ethnic and Gender Stereotypes
